Tournament Rules

1. Players start with 10,000 in tournament chips.
2. Levels 1-12 last 30 minutes. Levels 13 & up are 45 minutes. Registration will be open until the beginning of level 7. Players may re-enter during registration. Any player eliminated on Friday may enter on Saturday. Any player who did not play on Friday is eligible to play on Saturday.
3. TDA Rules will be in effect for this event.
4. Each player will pay a \$360 fee. \$291 is the entry fee, \$9 will go towards the promotion fee, and \$50 is the registration fee \$10 to the staff.
5. On each flight, play will continue until 15% (rounded down) of the field remains. At that point, play will resume until 10% (rounded up) of the field remains with anyone eliminated receiving \$500. All remaining players will advance to day 2.
6. Play will restart at 10:00AM on Sunday and continue until a winner is determined.
7. 100% of all tournament promotion fees will be paid to the players in the Tournament Leader Board Promotion. The payments will be in the form of tournament entries or tournament entry chips.

The Mississippi Gaming Commission reserves the right to investigate any and all complaints and disputes regarding tournaments, promotions and drawings. Such disputes and complaints will be resolved in accordance with the Mississippi Gaming Control Act and Mississippi Gaming Commission Regulations.
